Overview


The 4.6 release of Certainty arrives with a new look to the admin portal menus, with new navigation and organization features, as well as improvements to security with new Angular software architecture, new tools for smooth workflow management from the admin portal, and quality of life features for account creation and OData tools.

Workflow Step Controls


Checklist and actions workflow steps are tracked from the 'Completed Checklist' and 'Action' menus in the admin portal and can now be changed to different steps with admin permissions. To edit a checklist workflow, you can edit the workflow step by selecting 'edit' from the three-dot dropdown menu from either the completed checklist menu or the completed checklist focus menu. For editing ongoing Action Workflows, select 'edit' from the three-dot dropdown menu in the 'Actions' tab, or the action focus menu.



Checklist and actions workflow notifications have also been improved, with new options on rules to trigger notification or action creation on certain steps, conditional questions, and answers.

New UI Design for the Admin Portal

The admin portal has been updated with new formatting and looks, as well as a few small quality-of-life features. The updated visuals include some rearrangements of menus - such as the page tabs moving into an organized list beside the current menu.



This side menu can also be locked or unlocked, locking it hides the UI until the side panel is moused over, where you can 'unlock' it once again, so it stays maximized at the side of the screen.

New Account Creation Controls

Settings have been put in place to prevent several minor duplicates that could cause issues for logins and notifications. Most notably, there is now a setting to block email duplicates, any new instances will have this setting enabled by default.

OData Improvements

Several new columns have been added to the tables available through our OData system, including the last login date, various workflow-related entries, and site addresses.

Various Bug Fixes

A variety of minor bugs have also been addressed and fixed in this release.
